### Partnership Learning Timeline

<b>May 2011</b>	Barking and Dagenham Co-operative Learning Partnership (BDCLP) set up to develop Free School bids in B & D	
<b>Feb 2012</b>	Riverside Secondary School free school bid submitted	Opened Sept 2013
<b>Dec 2012</b>	BDCLP replaced by new Trust – The Partnership Learning Trust	
<b>Jan 2013</b>	Riverside Bridge Special School free school bid submitted	Opened Sept 2015
<b>Apr 2014</b>	Local primary - Thames View Junior School (TVJ) – fails its Ofsted inspection and asks the Trust to sponsor its conversion to academy status.	
<b>Aug 2014</b>	Riverside Primary School free school bid submitted	Opened Sept 2015
<b>Oct 2014</b>	Greatfields Secondary School free school bid submitted	Opened Sept 2016
<b>Nov 2014</b>	DfE approves the Trust as an academy sponsor	
<b>Dec 2014</b>	Trust changes its name to Partnership Learning	
<b>Feb 2015</b>	Partnership Learning begins life as a Multi-Academy Trust (MAT) and approved sponsor, with the simultaneous academy conversions of Thames View Junior School and The Sydney Russell School plus Riverside Secondary School joining the new MAT	
<b>March 2016</b>	Beam High School, Greatfields Primary School and Mallard Primary School free school bids submitted	Approved Sept 2016
<b>Sept 2016</b>	Beam Bridge Special School free school bid submitted	Approved Apr 2017
<b>Dec 2016 onwards</b>	Partnership Learning expands, with the addition of:

	Hornchurch High School (Havering)	Joined Dec 2016
	The James Cambell Primary School (Barking & Dagenham)	Joined May 2017
	Harrow Lodge Primary School (Havering)	Joined March 2018
