May 2011	Barking and Dagenham Co-operative Learning Partnership (BDCLP) set up to develop Free School bids in B & D	
Feb 2012	Riverside Secondary School free school bid submitted	Opened Sept 2013
Dec 2012	BDCLP replaced by new Trust – The Partnership Learning Trust	
Jan 2013	Riverside Bridge Special School free school bid submitted	Opened Sept 2015
Apr 2014	Local primary - Thames View Junior School (TVJ) – fails its Ofsted inspection and asks the Trust to sponsor its conversion to academy status.	
Aug 2014	Riverside Primary School free school bid submitted	Opened Sept 2015
Oct 2014	Greatfields Secondary School free school bid submitted	Opened Sept 2016
Nov 2014	DfE approves the Trust as an academy sponsor	
Dec 2014	Trust changes its name to Partnership Learning	
Feb 2015	Partnership Learning begins life as a Multi-Academy Trust (MAT) and approved sponsor, with the simultaneous academy conversions of Thames View Junior School and The Sydney Russell School plus Riverside Secondary School joining the new MAT	
March 2016	Beam High School, Greatfields Primary School and Mallard Primary School free school bids submitted	Approved Sept 2016
Sept 2016	Beam Bridge Special School free school bid submitted	Approved Apr 2017
Dec 2016	Partnership Learning expands, with the addition of:
